G. M. Momin Women's College was established by the Konkan Muslim Education Society in July 1989 with the sole aim of providing education to middle class and lower middle class women primarily of Muslim community. From a humble and modest beginning the college has come a long way with around 1800 students studying in undergraduate and postgraduate courses in Arts, Science and Commerce faculties. Apart from conventional streams, the college also enrolls students for Undergraduate and Post-Graduate courses in Management Studies, Information Technology, Biotechnology, Inter-Disciplinary studies and various Ph.D programmes of the University of Mumbai.
